**Conditions of Use:** - An antique vehicle may only be used for:

- exhibitions, club activities, parades, and other like functions
- presentation of the vehicle at a Designated Inspection Facility for obtaining vehicle repairs, but not for general transportation
- participation in weddings and graduations
- public functions such as the opening of new highways, bridges and public buildings
- carrying a load for the purposes of parades or exhibitions

### Caution:

An antique vehicle may not be used for any business or commercial undertaking.

An antique vehicle being test-driven by a potential buyer may not **use Vintage** plates.

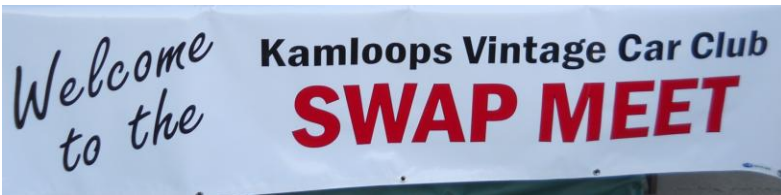
**GARY VAN DYKE'S Memorial Run**

We attended the Sorrento Show and Shine on Sat., Sept 8/2012. – It was a very nice day and

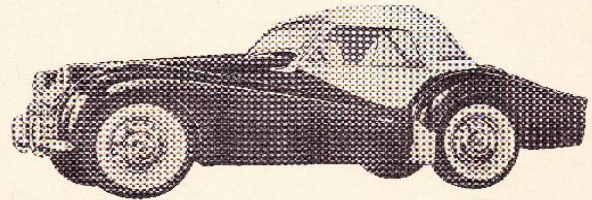
Sorrento put on a good show with many cars and trucks on display.
